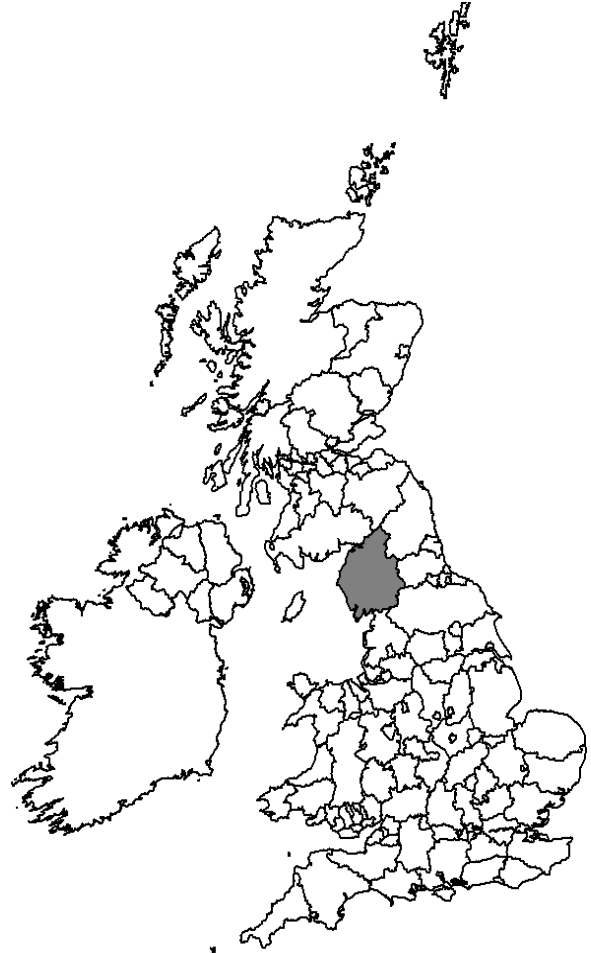

## **Extreme Rainfall Update Alert**

Start of event: 06:00 on Wednesday, 10 August 2011

End of event: 10:00 on Thursday, 11 August 2011

There is a 20% probability of rainfall amounts exceeding 50 millimetres in 6 hours  
Event total accumulations of 120 millimetres are possible

**In some areas within those highlighted  
extreme rainfall may lead to surface water flooding  
Consider activating your emergency procedures**

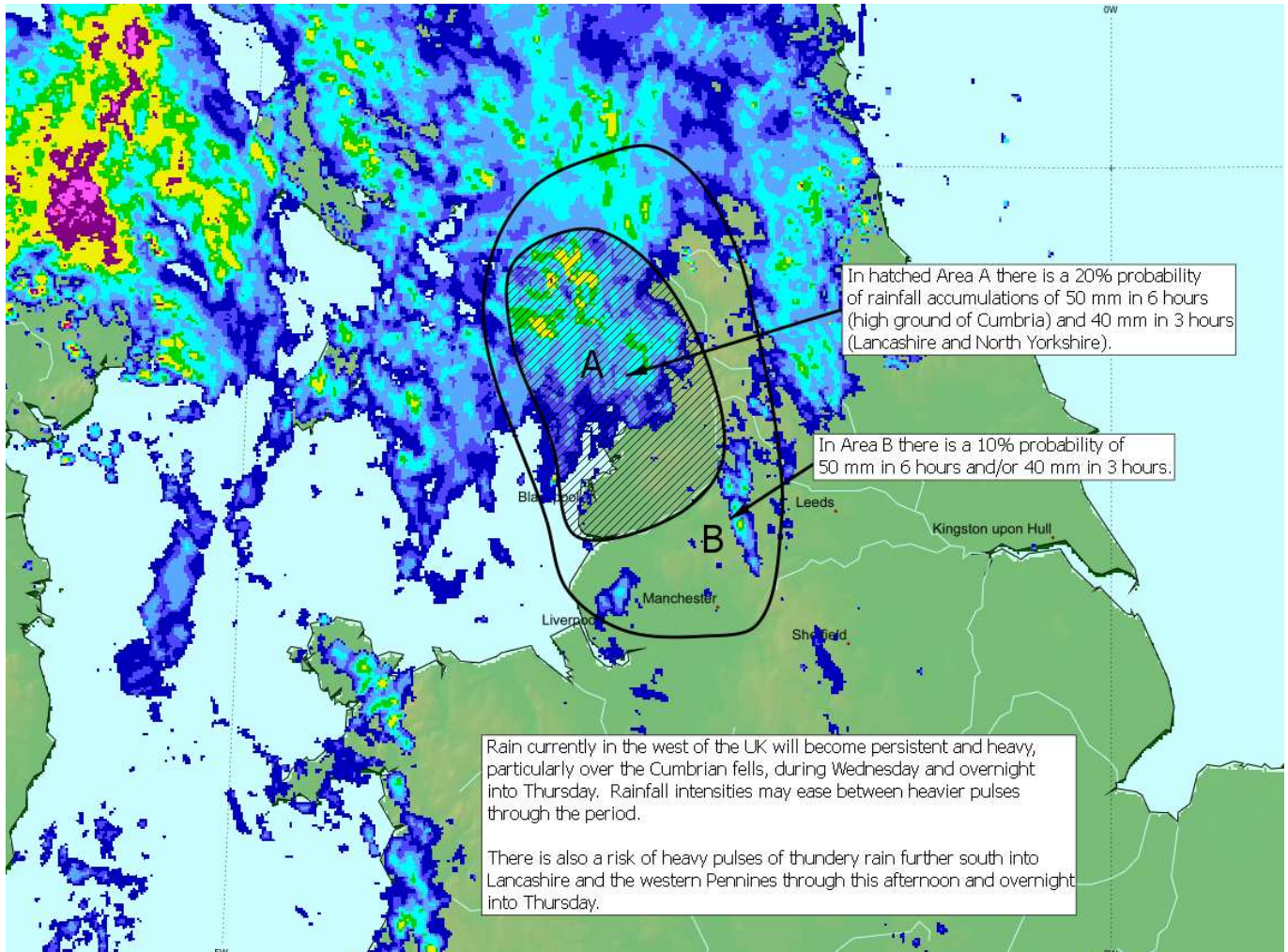
