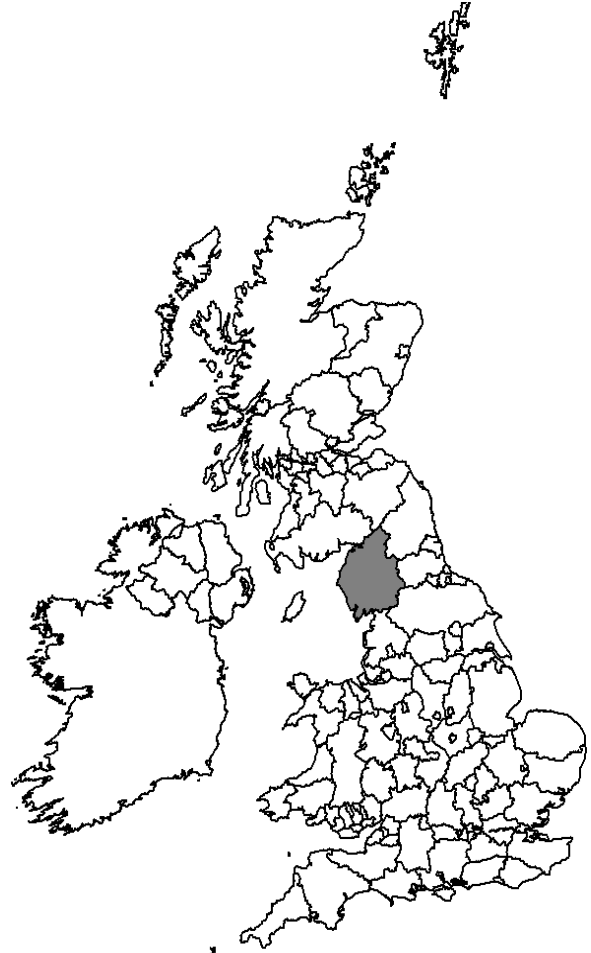

Event total accumulations of 120 millimetres are possible

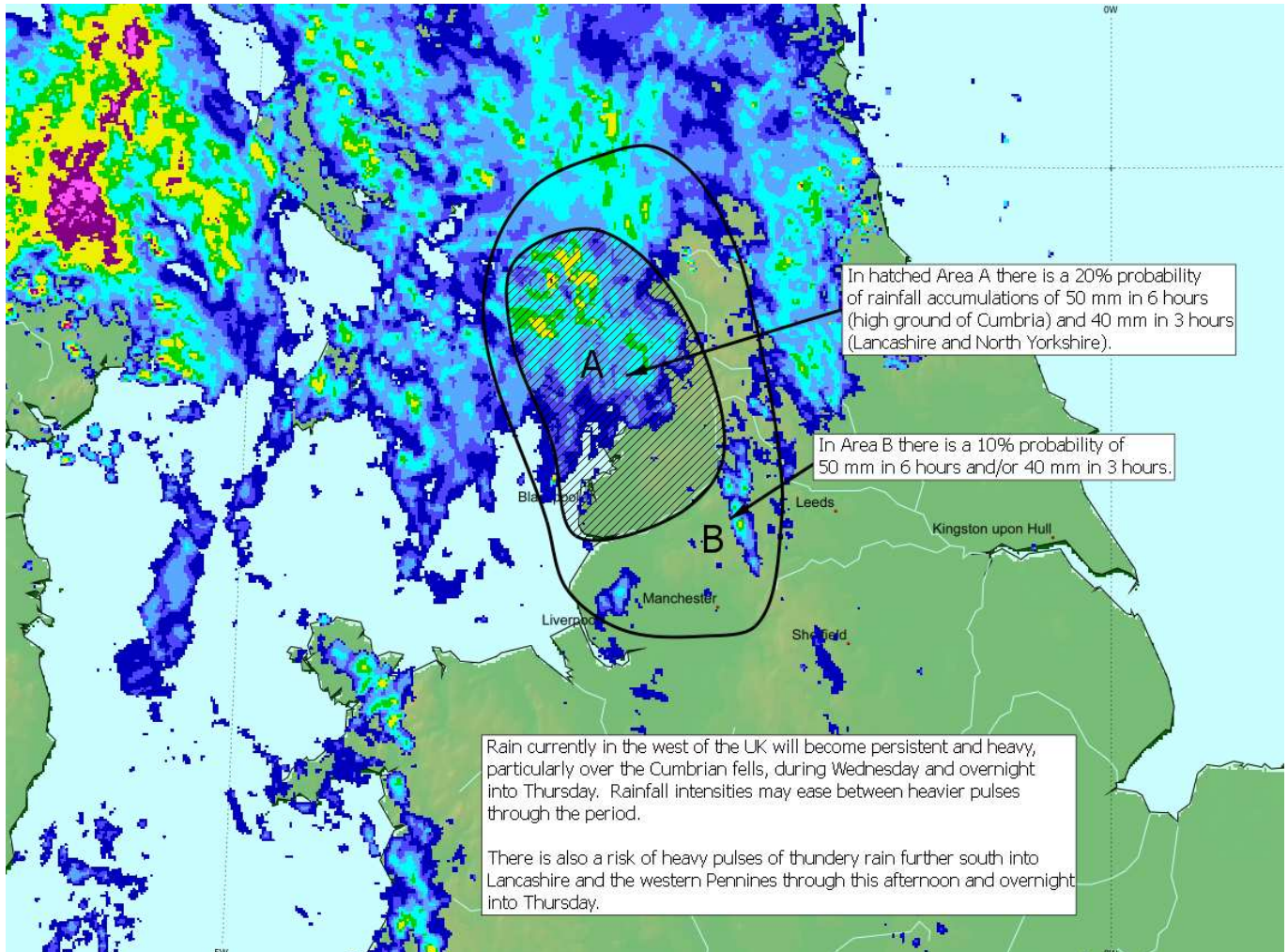
